
MISSION STATEMENT

The fussy Eater!

Why does my child refuse to eat?

- 1. He may not be hungry. A child's appetite can slow down between the age of 2 to 5 years, when he's growing slower. Let your child eat, when he's hungry and stop eating, when he's full.
- 2. Offer 3 healthy meals and 2 to 3 snacks about the same times, each day. Let your child decide, how much he will eat. Get more information at:
